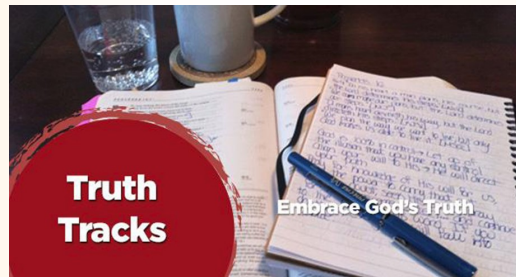

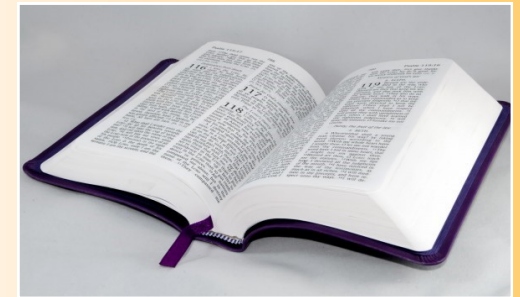

Description: This class is a study of Moses and the Burning Bush, adapted from the book and video by R.C. Sproul.

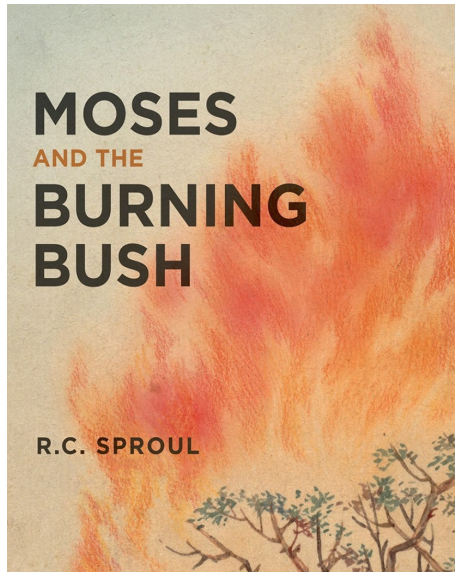
Key questions:

How is the burning bush relevant to Christians today?

1. The holiness of God.
2. The coming of Jesus as foreshadowed in this meeting between God and Moses.
3. The importance of God's words to Moses.
4. I AM: the Name of God.
5. I AM: The Being of God.
6. I AM: The Aseity of God

Description: This class will discuss the Biblical Vs. Materialist View of Human Nature. We will view a presentation by Dr. Laura Hendrickson about the features of Cognitive-Perceptual disorders and helping those with these disorders. We will seek to understand a Biblical approach to parenting that is more than a formula.

Key questions:

Is Emotional Pain a Disease?

What Medicines Are Given for Emotional Pain?

What formulas for parenting have people tried?

What is the biggest problem with formulas for parenting? Why is discipline necessary?

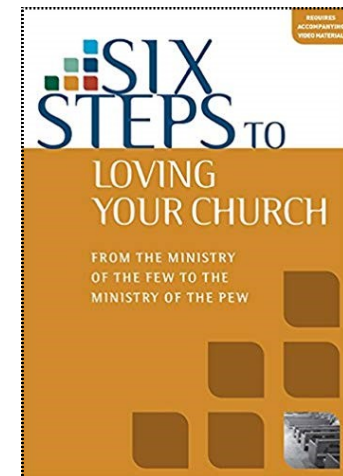
Class: Foundations. (Office Conference Room)
