Dennis and Coletta Shelly

Coletta taught English, English writing and Community Health issues to seminary wives. They are currently located in Lancaster, PA, where they aid ETSK in public relations and Fellowship International Mission in missions-church relations in their local area. Their continued prayer need is for protection at the seminary as security is a serious problem. They pray for peace in Nigeria between the Christians and Muslims. God's Character

Let us rejoice that we worship and serve "the God of peace" (Rom. 15:33; 16:20; Phil. 4:9; 1 Thess. 5:23; Heb. 13:20). "God's peace means that in God's being and in his actions he is separate from all confusion and disorder, yet he is continually active in innumerable well-ordered, fully controlled, simultaneous actions" (Grudem, Systematic Theology, p. 203). We could say that God is the ultimate multi-tasker! Clearly, such controlled activity requires infinite wisdom, knowledge and power!

God's Church

Pray that God would grant us inner strength (Eph. 3:14-16), so that we might experience spiritual renewal on a continual basis. Though our tendency is to pray for our physical health needs, Scripture places far greater emphasis on our spiritual health. David testified to the Lord, "On the day I called, you answered me; my strength of soul you increased" (Psalm 138:3). May that be our testimony too, as we depend on the Holy Spirit to fill our inner person with God's power!
