## [Prayer Points](#)

- God's Character: Let us rejoice that we worship and serve "the God of peace" (Rom. 15:33; 16:20; Phil. 4:9; 1 Thess. 5:23; Heb. 13:20). "God's peace means that in God's being and in his actions he is separate from all

actions” (Grudem, Systematic Theology, p. 203). We could say that God is the ultimate multi-tasker! Clearly, such controlled activity requires infinite wisdom, knowledge and power!

- **God's Church:** Pray that God would grant us inner strength (Eph. 3:14-16), so that we might experience spiritual renewal on a continual basis. Though our tendency is to pray for our physical health needs, Scripture places far greater emphasis on our spiritual health. David testified to the Lord, “On the day I called, you answered me; my strength of soul you increased” (Psalm 138:3). May that be our testimony too, as we depend on the Holy Spirit to fill our inner person with God’s power!
- **Missionary of the Month: Dennis and Coletta Shelly**
  - Pray for the students at ETSK and for Student Work Scholarship and Skill Acquisition Center funds.
  - For Nigeria’s government leaders to have integrity, fight corruption, help to improve the economy, and be fair in protecting all people around the country, whether they are Christians or Muslims. For the government to be able to reduce continual attacks and bombings by Fulani herdsmen and Boko Haram militants especially in central and northern Nigeria.
  - Pray for Dennis and Colletta as they adjust to living in the US after over 40 years serving in Nigeria, and for continued healing for Dennis after his hip and leg injury last year.
