John and Celia Fletcher


John and Celia Fletcher’s journey with Pioneers began in the early 1980s in Papua New Guinea. There, among the Kubo tribal people, they worked to make disciples and plant a church, with John specializing in linguistics and Bible translation, while Celia served as a nurse. Today, John serves as the Sr. Vice President of Global Ministries, working to enhance ministry synergy among Pioneers’ 3,000+ members serving on 345 teams among 207 unreached people groups in nearly 100 countries. John also provides accountability for the U.S. office leaders of Mobilization, Pre-field Ministries, Member Development, Church Partnerships, Arab World Initiatives, and Orality Ministries and seeks to encourage and consult with Pioneers’ international leaders, mobilization bases and partners around the world. John and Celia live in Orlando, Florida, where Celia also continues to work in nursing with children with disabilities. The Fletchers have four adult children - John, Catherine, Jaclyn (who went to be with the Lord in 2015), and Christa.
