**Missionary of the Month**

**Andrew and Anna Smith**

Andrew and Anna are missionaries with Ethnos360 Aviation. Married in 2017, they spent their first two years of marriage living in Virginia where Anna worked as an RN in the local hospital and Andrew gained experience as an aircraft mechanic at Dynamic Aviation. Then, in 2019 they spent one year studying at the Missionary Training Center for Ethnos360. There Andrew has been learning how to fly in the same fashion as the rest of the mission's pilots, receiving training in the Kodiak 100 simulator, and striving to earn his Certified Flight Instructor rating. They have just moved to their missions placement in Papua New Guinea where Andrew is a pilot/mechanic and Anna is a nurse. They serve and support missionaries by getting missionaries and supplies to the hard to reach places in PNG and make church plants and outreach possible.

**Prayer Requests**

- Pray for the aviation program the Smiths are a part of in PNG. They will be down to only one training pilot (Brent Haberchak) in a few weeks. There are two pilots, plus Andrew, who are still in training to be able to safely navigate dangerous airstrips and high stress flying situations.
- Pray for the Haberchak family as they are entering a very demanding season. Pray for Brent to have wisdom in balancing the huge tasks ahead of him, and pray he would not burn out.
- Pray for Andrew to trust God with his training. His training will take longer since there is only one training pilot being shared between three students.
- Pray that Andrew and Anna would grow closer to the Lord individually and as a couple.
- Pray for safety as their container should be leaving the city of Lae soon and being delivered via truck through curvy roads that have been known to cause large trucks to tip over.
